

WINE COUNTRY YARN HOP 2023

GARDEN PARTY COWL

BY PURLS OF JOY



SIZES One size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Height 15" Bottom circumference 42"

YARN

Fingering/Sock weight yarn.

MAIN COLOR – 450 yards **COLOR 1 & COLOR 2** – 92 yards each (20 gram minis)

Yarn used – Comfort and Joy Yarn Co Enjoy sock set 2023 Yarn Hop colorway “Garden Party”

NEEDLES

US 6 24” & 32” circular needles (may use a 16” circular to begin)

OTHER

Stitch markers BOR marker tapestry needle

GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows in 4” in Stockinette Stitch after blocking.

ABBREVIATIONS

MC Main Color **C1** Color 1 **C2** Color 2

K Knit **P** Purl **Sts** Stitches

R Round **pm** place marker **YO** Yarn Over

kfb Knit in the front & back of the stitch (1 st increased)

ssk Slip slip knit (1 st decreased) **K2tog** Knit two stitches together (1 st decreased)

M1L Make one left - Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and the next stitch from front to back. Place strand on left needle and knit through the back (one stitch increased).

s2kp Slip two stitches knitwise, K1, pass slipped stitches over the K1.

NOTES

The Garden Party Cowl is a light and airy project. Perfect to layer over summer dresses and tops. In the cool of the evening the cowl can become a cozy shoulder warmer. Lace sections are a lovely feminine touch, and the dainty picot edge is reminiscent of days gone by. A graceful accessory to brighten any wardrobe.

The cowl is worked from the neckline down and made with three colors. It begins with 120 sts and ends with 255 sts. A variety of patterns is just enough to keep one’s interest and perhaps offer a challenge to some knitters.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 120 sts with **Color 1**. Join to knit in the round, placing BOR (beginning of round) marker.
Purl five rounds.

SECTION 1 LACE

Change to **MC** and knit one round, placing stitch markers after every 10 stitches. BOR marker should be different than other markers.

R1 Knit all stitches, slipping markers as you come to them.

R2 Purl all stitches.

R3 & 4 K all sts.

R5 *K1, YO, K3, s2kp, K3, YO* Repeat from * to * around, slipping markers as you come to them.

R6 *K2, YO, K2, s2kp, K2, YO, K1* Repeat.

R7 *K3, YO, K1, s2kp, K1, YO, K2* Repeat.

R8 *K4, YO, s2kp, YO, K3* Repeat

R 9, 11, 13 & 14 K all sts.

R 10 & 12 P all sts.

R15 *K1, YO, K3, s2kp, K3, YO* Repeat

R16 *K2, YO, K2, s2kp, K2, YO, K1* Repeat

R17 *K3, YO, K1, s2kp, K1, YO, K2* Repeat

R18 *K4, YO, s2kp, YO, K3* Repeat

R 19, 20 & 22 K all sts.

R 21 P all sts.

SECTION 2 STRIPES

This section has alternating stripes using Color 1 and 2. Carry your yarns as you change colors. Each stripe will have a knit round then a purl round. Color 1 rounds are increase rounds.

Change to **C2**.

Knit one round. Purl one round.

Change to **C1**

R1 *Knit to one stitch before marker, kfb* Repeat around.

R2 Purl all sts.

Continue the pattern above, alternating colors and increasing on **C1** knit rows, four more times.
End with an additional repeat of **C2**. There will be 11 stripes and 170 sts.

SECTION 3 STOCKINETTE

Change to **MC**. Knit four rounds, removing all markers except BOR. Markers will be placed in new positions in R5.

R5 *K7, P3, K7, **pm*** repeat around to BOR.

R 6, 7 & 8 Knit all sts, slipping markers as you come to them.

R9 *K8, M1L, K9* Repeat 180 sts

R10 *P3, K15* repeat

R 11, 12 & 13 K all sts

R14 *K12, M1L, K6* Repeat 190 sts

R15 *K8, P3, K8* repeat

R 16, 17 & 18 K all sts

R19 *K4, M1L, K15* Repeat 200 sts

R20 *P3, K17* repeat

R 21, 22 & 23 K all sts

R24 *K6, M1L, K14 REPEAT 210 STS

R25 *K10, P3, K8* repeat

R 26, 27 & 28 K all sts

R29 *K6, M1L, K15* Repeat 220 sts

R30 *P3, K18* repeat

R 31, 32 & 33 K all sts Repeat

R34 *K10, M1L, K12* 230 sts

SECTION 4 BEADED RIB STITCH

This section will have 23 sts between markers. To accommodate the pattern, *do not remove markers, slip them as you come to them and continue the pattern.*

Change to **C1**.

R1 *P2, K1, P1, K1* Repeat

R2 *P2, K3* Repeat

Repeat **R1** and **R2** four more times

NEXT ROUND *K11, M1L, K12* Repeat. 240 sts

SECTION 5 FEATHER AND FAN LACE

A 17 stitch pattern repeat. Pattern setup:

Change to **MC**.

R1 *K16, M1L* repeat to BOR, removing markers as you come to them, except for BOR marker. They will be replaced next round.

R2 K all sts, placing markers after every 17 sts.

R3 *K2tog (3X), YO, K1 (5X), YO, ssk (3X)*, repeat

R4 P all sts.

EYELET PATTERN

R 1 & 2 K all sts

R3 *K2tog (3X), YO, K1 (5X), YO, ssk (3X)* Repeat

R4 P all sts.

Repeat Pattern **rounds 1 through 4** five more times.

PICOT BIND OFF

Change to **C2**.

STEP 1 Using the knitted cast on method, cast on three stitches.

STEP 2 Knit two sts, lift the first knitted stitch on the right needle over the second stitch – one stitch bound off. Knit another stitch and repeat the bind off.

STEP 3 Slip the stitch on the right needle back to the left needle and knit it together with the next stitch through the back loop. Repeat this step three more times.

Continue binding off all sts by repeating **steps 1 through 3**. Knit any remaining stitches and bind them off. Cut yarn, weave in ends and finish off. Block to define lace sections. Enjoy!
