Lobed Leaf Cowl

SIZES

One size cowl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Blocked - 11" X 28"

YARN

Dream In Color – Smooshy Cashmere – Lay A Rose – 1 skein Dream In Color – Billy Kid Silk – Relish the Vote – 2 skeins OR approximately 400 yards fingering and 400 yards lace mohair

NEEDLES

US Size 7 26" circular

OTHER TOOLS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle

GAUGE

20 sts = 4" in St st

ABBREVIATIONS

Yarn Over

Ssk – slip 1 as if to K, slip 2nd st as if to K then knit them together

Sl 1 K2tog psso – slip 1, K2tog, pass slip st over the K2tog

| Ssk − si
| Sl 1 K2
| K2tog
| A K3tog

M1L – pick up strand between the two sts front to back and K into the back

NOTES

The Lobed Leaf Cowl is knit with a strand of each yarn held together.

To increase the height, add additional repeats of the chart. To increase the length, add 27 sts to your desired length.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 161 sts with a long tail cast on using both yarns held together. Join in the round without a twist. Work in Seed St for 6 rounds. Increase 1 st at end of round by making 1 left (162 sts).

Round 1 – Knit all stitches placing a marker every 27 stitches to set up for the chart. Use a different color marker for the beginning of round.


Follow the 10-row chart from right to left repeating it 6 times or to your desired height.

Knit 1 row removing the markers as you go and decreasing 1 st at end of round using K2tog. Work 6 rounds of Seed St.

Bind off loosely by *K2tog tbl, return stitch to left needle* repeat between * * for the round.

FINISHING

Weave in your ends. Soak in lukewarm water with a little bit of ph neutral soap if desired (Eucalan). Let it soak for 30 minutes. Roll in towel to squeeze out excess water. Lay flat to dry, pinning if necessary.



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
